

# Blue Box Recycling

## Blue Box Recycling



**Place shredded paper in a clear plastic bag, not loose in your Blue Box, and set out for curbside recycling collection.**



Collected weekly on your regular collection day.

### **Rinse and place these “containers” loose in one Blue Box**

All plastic bottles with a twist-off top, plastic tubs & lids (yogurt & ice cream type containers), metal food & beverage containers, glass bottles & jars, paper milk & juice cartons, empty aerosol & empty metal paint cans with lids removed.

### **Place these “papers” loose in a second Blue Box**

Junk mail & envelopes, catalogues, magazines, paperback books & phone books, newspapers, office paper & computer paper.

### **Cardboard & Boxboard**

Fold boxes flat. Cut, tie and bundle about the same size as your Blue Box. Place next to or on top of your Blue Boxes.

**See photo on back cover for proper set out along the curb.**

### **Extra & Replacement Blue Boxes**

Extra and replacement Blue Boxes are available during regular business hours from the Durham Region Recycling Centre, 4600 Garrard Road, Whitby. Extra Blue Boxes are also available at Miller Waste Systems, 1220 Squires Beach Road, Pickering. A fee will apply for extra Blue Boxes.

# Remember to separate your Blue Box Recyclables

## CONTAINERS • Place loose in one Blue Box!



All plastic bottles with a twist-off top



Milk, juice & drink cartons



Glass bottles & jars



Margarine, yogurt & ice cream tubs



Metal food & beverage cans



Empty aerosol & paint cans



## PAPER • Place loose in second Blue Box!



Junk mail & envelopes



Catalogues & phone books



Office, computer & scrap paper



Newspapers



### PLASTIC BAGS

should NOT be included with recycling. Please place recyclables 'loose' inside your Blue Boxes.

## BOXBOARD & CARDBOARD • Flatten & bundle!



### Boxboard

Cereal boxes (liners removed), tissue boxes, detergent boxes, toilet paper and paper towel rolls

### Cardboard

Moving boxes & clean pizza boxes
